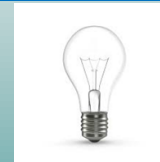


Driver: History

Hear—When you *hear*, you perceive a noise made by someone or something

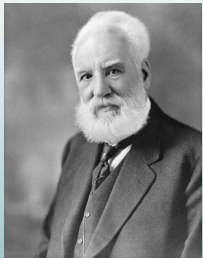
Sound—A *sound* is a noise, something you can hear if you're in the right spot and it's loud enough.
