## Parking Code of Conduct

School parking has been an ongoing local issue in our community. The Academy has been working hard with both the local community, parents and other organisations to look at different ways of tackling the challenges and impact of parking activity around key school times.

We understand parents have varying time pressures particularly in the morning, when needing to drop children off at school and also to get to work. In order to save time, many drivers will then park as near to the school as possible, even if it creates an obstruction or presents a safety risk for other pedestrians/drivers in the area.

A Code of Conduct for parking is one way to deliver the message to encourage considerate parking behaviour. This Code of Conduct will not only ensure the safety of our children travelling to and from school, but also assist in reducing some of the wider impacts experienced by the local community.

### The Parking Code of Conduct

Local feedback suggests the main areas of concern are:

- Parking/congestion down the streets within the immediate vicinity of the school e.g. Latimer Road
- Grass verge parking
- Parking on yellow zigzag lines

Our aims through the Code of Conduct and other measures are to:

- Reduce congestion around the immediate area of the school
- Make the area safer for children/pedestrians en route to school.
- Be mindful of residents' concerns
- Investigate and where possible, implement projects/initiatives to encourage higher levels of walking as a sustainable form of transport to get to school.

With these in mind, we would ask you to remember the following:

- The yellow zigzag lines in front of the main school entrance on Rowlett Road are designed to allow a clear view up and down the road for children to cross safely. If you stop, even to drop off, on these lines, you are making it dangerous for children to cross by obscuring their view.



- Avoid parking around road junctions so that children can cross safely. It is an offence to park within 10 metres (3 car lengths) of a junction.
- Be considerate to the local residents in many surrounding roads including Latimer Road area by avoiding parking across driveways or on grass verges. Most residents like the grass verges as an attractive feature in their street and don't like to see them churned up. It is also an offence to park on a grass verge in any way that prevents pedestrians or wheelchair/pram users from accessing the footpath.
- Try parking further away from the school. This has several advantages. You will find it easier to find a space or an area to turn your car around for your return journey, it will also be an opportunity for your children to enjoy walking and for them to learn road safety skills.

We hope that you will support us in helping to reduce some of the parking problems around the school by thinking about your driving/parking behaviour and making some small changes to where, or how you park.
