Year 3 Autumn One Newsletter

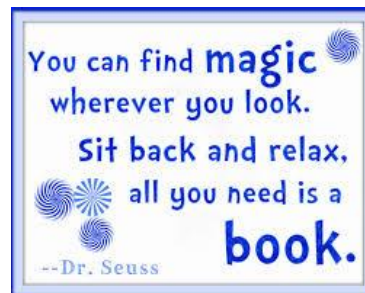


We hope you enjoyed your summer holiday and were able to have time to relax. May we take this opportunity to welcome you to Year Three; we have an exciting year ahead.
