



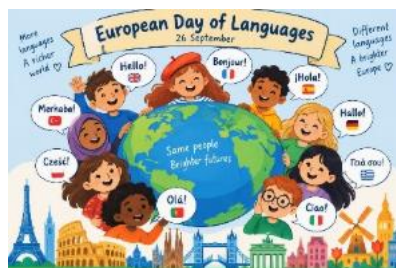

On Friday 25th September, we will be celebrating European Day of Languages. On this day, the children will be emersed in a range of activities to celebrate the languages and cultures around the world.

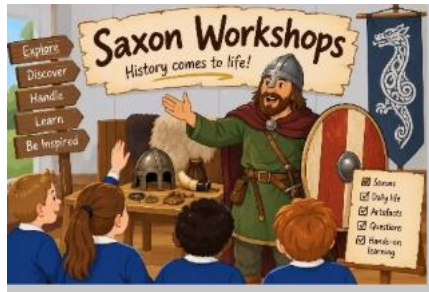

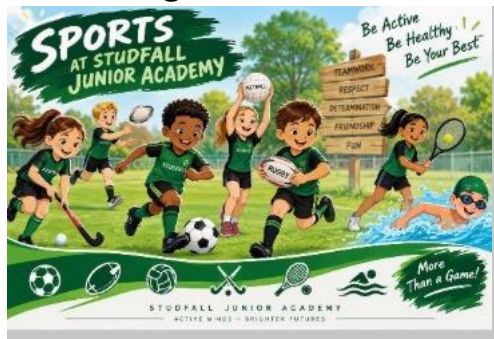

On the 7th October, year 5/6 girls will be taking part in a football tournament, and we know that they will give it everything they have got to succeed.

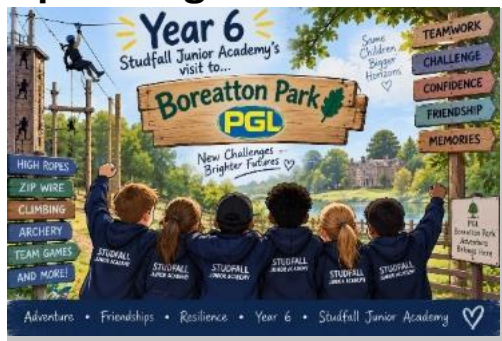
On the 14th October, year 4, 5 and 6 will be taking part in a cross-country event and we know that they will give it their all.
